Entry Fee: \$5 per artwork (maximum 5) Payable on delivery

\$2 per unframed artwork for exhibiting artists only (maximum 4)

No charge Hand painted cards (maximum 20)

Delivery time: Wednesday, 10th April 10am to 12 Noon

Collection: Wednesday 17th April 3.45pm to 4.15pm (NO EARLIER)

IMPORTANT: Paintings may only be removed from screens by committee members

- Open to Financial SMA members only.
- 2. SMA has right to reject works
- 3. <u>Copyright</u>: No infringement of Copyright permitted. Eg: Copies from other artists work; photographs from calendars, Readers Digest & Australiana books, etc.)
- 4. <u>Duty Days</u>: Members are required to assist in manning the Exhibition. Up to 2 entries requires 1 roster day. Greater than two entries requires 2 roster days. PLEASE INDICATE PREFERRED DAYS ON REVERSE SIDE OF ENTRY FORM. Members experiencing difficulties with this requirement please liaise with Exhibition Committee
- Insurance: Exhibitors must arrange their own insurance.
   No responsibility can be taken by the SMA or the venue for damage or loss incurred.
- Publicity: The Society may allow works on display to be reproduced by newspapers or TV during the Exhibition period.
- 7. All works must be for sale, prices not negotiable.
- 8. Entries must be as per Entry Form. No substitutions accepted.

### Please note:

Uncollected paintings will not be looked after. If artists do not ensure that someone else will pick up their paintings, they will NOT be taken home by a committee member.

### AUTUMN 2019 EXHIBITION ARTWORKS CONDITIONS



and strong staples or "D" rings.

- Screws, "D" rings & wire ends must be covered with tape to prevent damage to other works.
- Position of string or wire should be 1/3rd from top of frame.
- No wet paintings accepted.
- Works must have been completed within the last two years.
   <u>Please note:</u> Depending upon total number of works entered, some entitlements are available for displaying previously exhibited works.

   Please read carefully in 'MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ARTWORKS' Item 2 below.
- Artists name and the title, price and medium must be clearly displayed on the back of the artwork and must agree with information on the Entry form.
- Unframed stretched canvasses must have no visible staples. All edges must be painted and ready to hang.
  - "Unframed canvasses" are considered part of the 5 entered artworks & **do not** qualify as "Unframed paintings" as described below.
- <u>Unframed paintings</u> Must be on a sturdy support and covered with clear protective plastic.
   Unframed works must also display price sticker on front of plastic cover.
- MAXIMUM SIZE OF ARTWORKS: up to 380cm (150") maximum outside perimeter.

(including frame).

2. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ARTWORKS: 5 paintings per exhibitor NOTE ADDITIONAL NEW CONDITION:

5 paintings entered entitles entry of: up to 2 paintings (as part of the 5) previously exhibited once only. less than 5 paintings entered entitles entry of: only 1 painting (as part of the total) previously exhibited once only.

### 3. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF UNFRAMED PAINTINGS:

Exhibiting artists may enter up to 4 unframed works.

(Note: "Unframed canvasses" do not qualify as "Unframed paintings".)

### 4. MAXIMUM SIZES & NUMBER OF HANDPAINTED CARDS:

- · Max 20 cards per participating artist
- Max envelope size 13 x 24cm
- . Exhibitors must include card details on the back of the Entry form
- Cards must be numbered from 1 to 20 with artists initials IN BLOCK CAPITALS and the price, in whole dollars (no cents) ON FRONT OF EACH CARD.
- · Each card must have an accompanying envelope in a cellophane sleeve.
