A commission of 25% will be deducted by the Society on any sale of artwork. Art works can be collected from the exhibition on Sunday May 18th between 4 & 5pm.

We look forward to welcoming both the art community and the public of the Blue Mountains to join us at our Historic Precinct for this Open Weekend and Exhibition.


