30th Anniversary Exhibition

To mark our 30th Anniversary in addition to the luncheon in June the Society has decided to have a 9x5 Exhibition as part of our Spring Exhibition. It will be hung and judged as a separate section.

Each exhibitor will be able to submit two paintings no entry charge. The Society will organise matching white frames and mats. Any medium and support will be suitable. We have obtained a very reasonable quote from local Hope Tree Framing 10 Station St Wentworth Falls. Cost \$56 per painting this includes fixing paintings in frames and attaching hanging cords. Minimum advertised price \$200 per painting. Full details will be available shortly. Members who have viewed the Tom Roberts Exhibition and also the Australian Exhibits in the National Gallery would have seen many 9x5 examples.

A SHORT 9x5 HISTORY

The **9** by **5** Impression Exhibition was an <u>art exhibition</u> in <u>Melbourne</u>, Australia. The exhibition was opened on 17 August 1889 in Buxton's Rooms on <u>Swanston Street</u> and featured 183 works; the majority of which were painted by the <u>Australian impressionists</u> <u>Tom Roberts</u>, <u>Charles Conder</u> and <u>Arthur Streeton</u>. The exhibition was named for the dimensions of most of the paintings—9 by 5 inches (23 cm × 13 cm), the size of a cigar box lid upon which many of the works were painted— and the <u>Impressionist</u> inspiration for the works.

The exhibition created much lively commentary at the time and is now seen as a "celebrated event in Australian art history". 9 by 5s continue to appear on the market; in 2009, Conder's *Centennial Choir at Sorrento* (cat. 151) sold at <u>Sotheby's</u> for <u>A</u>\$492,000. In 2012, to mark the 123rd anniversary of the exhibition, arts benefactor Max Carter donated four 9 by 5s (valued at over A\$3,000,000) to the <u>Art Gallery of South Australia</u>, the largest group of 9 by 5s ever given to an Australian public institution.

News from the Website Sub-committee


At the February meeting mention was made hat the Society's Website Sub-committee is planning throughout 2016
