## PRESIDENT'S REPORT - October 2023.

**Exhibition**; As I've already mentioned in the recent email to members, we had a very successful exhibition With 27 paintings sold and excellent feedback from visitors to the exhibition. Congratulations everyone and thank you to all who contributed and helped.

Management; On another topic, most members are aware that Patricia Carruthers and myself have taken dual roles for the SMA in the past year. Patricia is the Secretary as well as the Newsletter Editor, and I am President as well as Treasurer. Dennis West has been trying to resign but he was persuaded to step in as Vice President and has been instrumental in making the exhibition a success. Patricia and I are also looking after the Membership records and organizing demonstrations. I have also been responsible for organizing many of the details for the exhibition. We have not had an exhibition committee for the last two exhibitions so the load has fallen on the management committee and in particular, Dennis and myself. Both Patricia and I had agreed to continue on in our roles and add to them last year in the hope it would give time for the SMA to rebuild after the decimation that was caused by covid. Rebuilding has occurred to a large extent, and we are now up to 52 members. We still have a way to go but there has been an encouraging increase in membership as well as interest in the Society.

Patricia, myself and Dennis will all be resigning at the AGM in March 2024, and will not be standing again for re-election in any capacity. Unless there are some members willing to stand for essential Committee roles, the Society will be obliged to close down and I would hate to see that happen. Personally I derived so much enjoyment and friendship from the Society and I would like to continue to do that. If the Society closes down, that will mean that between Katoomba and Glenbrook, there would be no art society.

Please consider making a contribution to the management of the Society in some way. Even if it is as small contribution it would help rather than leaving everything to two or three people.
